In the name of the Father, and of the + Son, and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

The Holy Spirit calls us together as the people of God. In the waters of the Jordan, Jesus is revealed as the beloved Son of God. Through this great epiphany, Jesus fulfills all righteousness and becomes the servant of God who will bring forth justice and be a light to the nations. On this day we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord and we recall our own baptism and our baptismal blessings. We recall and celebrate our adoption as daughters and sons, the gift of the Holy Spirit, and the promised company of Almighty God when we "pass through the waters . . . the rivers . . . and the fire of this life."

In the waters of Baptism we too are washed by the Word, anointed by the Spirit, and named God's beloved children. As we receive the gifts of baptism in word, water, wine and bread this day, we are reminded that our baptismal mission is to proclaim good news to all who are oppressed or in need of God's healing.

Joined to Christ in the waters of baptism, we are clothed with God's mercy and forgiveness. Let us give thanks for the gift of baptism.

**We give you thanks, O God, for in the beginning your Spirit moved over the waters and by your Word you created the world, calling forth life in which you took delight.**

**Leader:** Through the waters of the flood you delivered Noah and his family. Through the sea you led your people Israel from slavery into freedom. At the river your Son was baptized by John and anointed with the Holy Spirit. By water and your Word you claim us as daughters and sons, making us heirs of your promise and servants of all.

**We praise you for the gift of water that sustains life, and above all we praise you for the gift of new life in Jesus Christ. Shower us with your Spirit, and renew our lives with your forgiveness, grace, and love. To you be given honor and praise through Jesus Christ our Lord in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever. Amen.**

**Virtual Communion**

In the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus took bread, and gave thanks; broke it, and gave it to his disciples, saying: Take and eat; this is my body, given for you. Do this in the remembrance of me.

**Scripture: Acts 19:1-7 (CEB)**

<sup>1</sup>While Apollos was in Corinth, Paul took a route through the interior and came to Ephesus, where he found some disciples. <sup>2</sup>He asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you came to believe?"

They replied, "We've not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit."

<sup>3</sup>Then he said, "What baptism did you receive, then?"

They answered, "John's baptism."

<sup>4</sup>Paul explained, "John baptized with a baptism by which people showed **they were changing their hearts and lives**. It was a baptism that told people about the one who was coming after him. This is the one in whom they were to believe. This one is Jesus." <sup>5</sup>After they listened to Paul, they were baptized in the **name of the Lord Jesus**. <sup>6</sup>When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began speaking in

other languages and prophesying. <sup>7</sup> Altogether, there were about twelve people.
